We are the Ibarra Sandoval family, made up of Daniel, Cesia, Eliana (6 years old), and Benjamín (4 years old). For the past two years, we have been serving with Lampeí Ministries, a ministry dedicated to church planting. Currently, the ministry has two churches in Morelia (Lomas and Canteras), as well as two Christian schools: one that serves kindergarten and elementary students (Onelife Academy), and a second that serves middle school and high school students (Aljaba Academy).

Specifically, we are serving in both churches in Morelia. Danny serves as an associate pastor, involved in teaching, discipleship, counseling, and other responsibilities. Meanwhile, Cesy primarily serves as a teacher at Onelife Academy and is also one of the leaders of the women's group.

We are grateful for the opportunity God has given us to serve Him, and we are happy to share with you what this past month has been like in our lives and ministry.

Women Growing in Their Identity

Cesy has been leading and teaching one of the women's groups through the Letter to the Colossians. It has been an in-depth study where the sisters have learned about all the riches they have in Christ and how this impacts their daily lives.

"Studying my identity in Christ has helped me overcome negative thoughts that had been rooted in my mind for years," one of them said.



Men Growing in Their Leadership

Danny, together with the team of pastors, has begun a series based on the book *The Masculine Mandate* by Richard Phillips, in which the men have been learning that God has entrusted them to "cultivate and keep their garden," that is, their work, wife, children, and ministry. ***"I am applying what I am learning at my job,"*** one of them said enthusiastically.

At the end of the month, Danny, together with a group of brothers from the evangelistic ministry Resplandece, went to the Hospital Civil of Morelia to share with the family members of those who are hospitalized. In addition to sharing the Word, they were also able to provide them with some physical food.
