## SERVING WITH THE HEART, FAITHFUL TO THE CALLING.



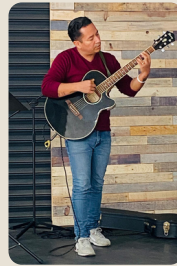

"And a threefold cord is not quickly broken."

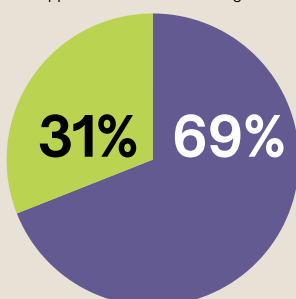
