We walk alongside our children in their growth and discipleship, integrating homeschooling and service, understanding mission as a life lived together—as a family.



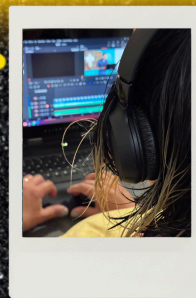
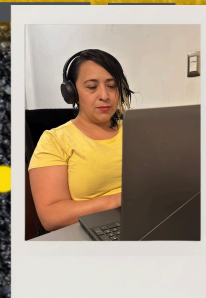
Learning to swim

An urban environment where there is a constant need for spiritual care and discipleship—and where today we are serving and learning how to swim.



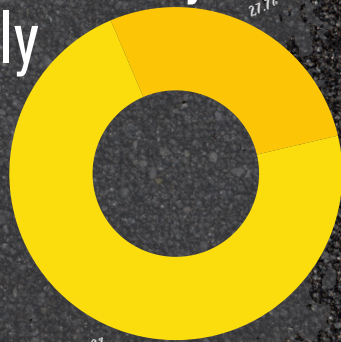

Our monthly expenses currently amount to approximately \$2,000 USD, which would allow us to serve full time.



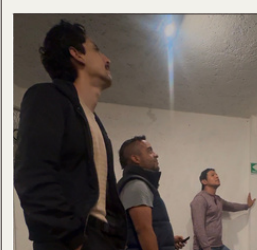
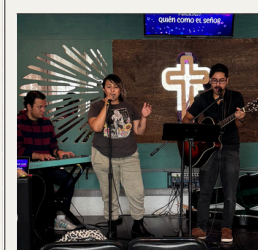
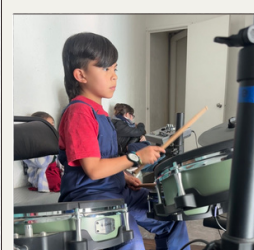
